What are the advantages of the region for businesses?



BZ: "Luxembourg benefits from several strategic advantages, to name only the main ones: the high level of competence of the financial sector coupled with cutting-edge fintech, and the presence of 136 banks, mainly international; a wide range of legal structures adapted to governance needs, such as those of wealth management or simply of a head holding company; legal and fiscal stability; multilingualism and a low social cost."

How far do you go in supporting companies that set up operations in Luxembourg?

BZ: "Before setting up a business, it's essential to first assess whether there's a genuine project and a real benefit to establishing oneself in Luxembourg. Next, it's crucial to understand the objectives in order to propose, after a feasibility study, the appropriate legal structure. Then come all the notarial, banking, and administrative formalities necessary to bring the chosen project to fruition. Finally, throughout the life of the company, it must establish its registered office, maintain accounting records, prepare and have its financial statements and profit allocation approved at shareholder meetings, file its tax returns, and ensure its governance and compliance with local and international societal developments. We are able to provide

comprehensive or customized support at these various stages, from the initial stages of a company's operation to its eventual closure."

Finally, are there any major projects coming up that will have an impact on the reception and arrival of foreign companies in Luxembourg?

BZ: "One of Luxembourg's defining characteristics is its versatility and its ability to identify innovative niches. To name just a few: space, with a strategy implemented by the Luxembourg Space Agency (LSA) and an ecosystem of over 80 companies and research organizations, employing more than 1,400 people; cleantech and biotechnology; intellectual property and data centers, with significant investment in supercomputers such as MeluXina and the operation of a quantum computer soon to be integrated into the supercomputer network. Luxembourg is also involved in developing mobility solutions in Lorraine. Finally, the government has established a single, multilingual digital portal, accessible to both individuals and businesses."
